This also includes having others post or say negative things as an extension of me. I understand my content can be viewed by ALL parties. "Private" social media accounts are not actually private. I acknowledge that cyber bullying of any kind WILL NOT be tolerated and is grounds for removal from the program.

I understand SLYC follows USASF's mission to strive for a safe environment for its athletes. With so much visible on social media, I know SLYC expects its athletes, coaches, friends and family members of the SLYC community to present themselves and the sport of cheer in the best light possible. Before I post, I will ask myself these three things:

"Is it Athletic?  
Is it Age Appropriate?  
What does it Amplify?"

I understand that any portrayal or photograph of me posted on any public forum that is in direct violation of the SLYC Code of Conduct and/or guidelines for appropriate behavior may result in immediate removal from the squad.

Furthermore, I understand it is forbidden to post videos of practices or competition performances of SLYC, and/or other towns, in their entirety unless given express permission from the Board of Directors.

I acknowledge SLYC's goal with these policies is to teach age appropriate cheerleading skills in a safe and fun environment. That they strive to help myself and my teammates to become respectful, confident cheerleaders with athletic integrity.
